# **Transitions**

Use transitions to move smoothly from paragraph to the next.

Transition words/phrases:

First, next, finally

First, also, next

Most importantly

One should also consider

Another option in explanatory writing for transitions is the use of headings.

Label each paragraph with a heading:

#### **Symptoms**

The symptoms of this disease are extreme. Once you contract the disease, your body will start to show signs by...

# **Spelling**

The more errors in your paper the less credible you appear to the reader.

Use the spell check function on Google Docs to help.

A note on medical words...

Another tip - Read your paper from right to left.

## Grammar

Make sure to capitalize the correct words:

Beginning of the sentence

Names of people and places

The word I

### Grammar

Use quotation marks " " around anything you quoted from a source (copied word for word).

Every sentence needs an end punctuation.

Make sure there is a space between the end punctuation in a sentence and the next word.

If your sentence is long and has a lot of commas, consider breaking it into multiple sentences..
